Health and Wellbeing

We have gym on a Tuesday and Friday this year so please make sure pupil have a kit in their bag or at school. Students will be learning a range of games to develop coordination, movement skills and social skills such as turn-taking and cooperation. CB7 will looking at gardening activities, where learners are developing important life skills such as responsibility, patience and teamwork, while also supporting their health and wellbeing through learning outdoors.



Literacy



Reading - This term we will be using a book study of *The Singing Mermaid*. Learners will develop early literacy and communication skills by listening to and engaging with the story. Activities support understanding, expression and enjoyment of reading.

Writing - Learners are using the Clicker programme to support the development of early writing skills, including sentence building, word recognition and independent expression.

Talking and Listening - To develop communication we will use social stories to support learners with transitions and upcoming visits, helping them to understand what to expect and feel more confident in new situations.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, through a range of practical activities, learners are exploring measuring and time. They will develop skills such as comparing size, using simple units and beginning to understand daily routines and sequencing. Some of learners will be using standard unit of measurement and looking at digital and analogue time.

Outdoor Learning



This term we plan on visiting a range of outdoor setting, the beach, parks and the woods. We will develop skills in mark-making, sensory play, and creative activities help build fine motor skills and communication. Please remember to provide welly boots so we can go out in all weather.

Interdisciplinary Learning



This term we will learn about Summer Experiences through trips to the beach and picnics, exploring the outdoors, engaging in sensory play and developing social and practical life skills. These activities support confidence, communication, teamwork, and enjoyment of the natural environment. Please return any EV5 as soon as possible.

Expressive Arts

Music - CB7 are looking forward to learning music with Ed from Drake Music.

Art and Design - We will explore summer-themed artwork using a variety of materials and sensory experiences. This supports creativity, fine motor skills, and engagement in hands-on learning.

Drama - CB7 will use characters from *The Singing Mermaid* to explore characterisation through sensory stories and tuff tray activities, supporting imagination, communication, and engagement.
