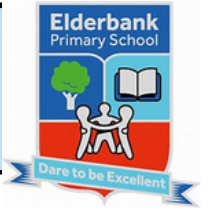


PRIMARY 1G-TERM 4

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

This term, we will learn about how everyone in our class is unique and make sure our classroom a welcoming place for all. The children will continue developing their understanding of their own feelings and the feelings of others, particularly when taking turns and sharing resources. In PE, we will focus on athletics and summer games, developing skills such as running, jumping and throwing.

LITERACY

This term, we will focus on developing our recall of sight words within a text. We will continue to learn single sounds and digraphs and use our knowledge of sounds to read and write short words.

The children will begin to identify and say the names of letters, building on their knowledge of letter sounds.

In writing, we will continue to focus on descriptive language within information reports and narrative texts.

NUMERACY

In term 4, we will continue to develop our number knowledge. The children will build on their skills in addition and subtraction through a range of practical activities and games. We will also learn about mass and capacity, exploring how to compare and measure the weight of different objects, using balance scales and everyday items.

LEARNING ACROSS THE CURRICULUM

During this term we will focus on the topic 'All Around the World'. We will learn about different countries, cultures, and environments from around the globe. We will explore different music and art from a variety of cultures and investigate these through creative and imaginative play. In religious education, we will focus on caring for others.
