HEALTH AND WELLBEING

This term we will learn about how everyone in our class is unique and how we can make our classroom a welcoming place for all. The children will continue developing their understanding of their own feelings and the feelings of others, particularly when taking turns and sharing resources. In PE, we will focus on athletics and summer games, developing skills such as running, jumping and throwing.

LITERACY

We will be focusing on developing our recall of sight words and recognising them within a text when reading. We will continue to learn phonics single sounds and digraphs, blending them together to read words and sounding words out to spell them. The children will begin to identify and say the names of letters, building on their knowledge of letter sounds. In writing, we will continue on descriptive language within information reports as well as looking at narratives.

NUMERACY

In term 4, we will continue developing our number knowledge and confidence when working with numbers. The children will build on their skills in addition and subtraction through a range of practical activities and games. We will also begin learning about mass, exploring how to compare and measure the weight of different objects using balance scales and everyday items.

LEARNING ACROSS THE CURRICULUM

During this term we will focus on the topic 'All Around the World'. We will learn about different countries, cultures, and environments from around the globe. We will explore different music and art from a variety of cultures and investigate these through creative and imaginative play. In religious education, we will focus on caring for others.

REMINDERS

Children require a gym bag, shorts and gym shoes. Gym bags will then remain in school and will be sent home at the end of each term to be freshened up.
