HEALTH AND WELLBEING

In Health and Wellbeing, we will be learning about the SHANARRI indicator of Included, exploring how everyone can feel valued and supported. In P.E, pupils will develop their skills through athletics and a range of summer and outdoor games, encouraging teamwork, coordination, and enjoyment of active play. Through these activities, children will also build confidence, resilience, and positive relationships with their peers.

LITERACY

In Literacy this term, pupils will continue to develop their phonics knowledge and apply this to their reading and writing. We are continuing our learning of diagraphs this term and will be focusing on new diagraphs. They will be working with a new reading book each week to build fluency, confidence, and enjoyment. Our writing focus will be on Narratives, where pupils will learn about sentence openers, the structure of a narrative and past tense verbs. The children will learn about how to answer 'how' and 'why' questions. We will have a variety of play experiences to support children in their learning.

NUMERACY

This term, we will be learning about fractions. We will be exploring halves and quarters and learning how to write a fraction. We will explore new strategies to help us add and subtract, as well as learning about estimating and rounding. We will continue to practice our multiplying and dividing skills. The children will further develop problem solving skills through using Building Thinking Classroom strategies. In maths, we will focus on patterns. We will explore repeating and growing patterns.

LEARNING ACROSS THE CURRICULUM

In Term 4, we will be learning about countries across the world. We will look at maps and explore the continents and oceans. We will compare and choose countries to learn about each week. We will explore these countries culture, food and language. There will be play provocations set up in class and in the open area to support their learning. The children will also learn about food safety and healthy eating during health week.
