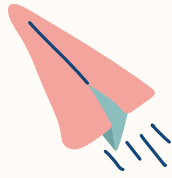


# PRIMARY 3M

### HEALTH & WELLBEING

In Term 4, Primary 3 will be involved in athletics and Summer team games. We will explore how eating together is an important time to interact with others; valuing the opportunities we are given to make friends and be part of a group in a range of situations. We will also take part in enjoying tasting a diversity of foods to encourage us when in a range of social situations.

We will continue to work on the importance of respect and compromise when working and sharing with others and consolidate all that has been learned over the year.

### LITERACY

**Reading:** We will continue to read our PM texts regularly and visit the school library to promote reading for enjoyment. We will complete weekly comprehension activities. This term we will be using all of our SHORS reading strategies but our main focus will be summarising.

**Writing:** Our focus will be on Narrative writing, whilst continuing Information Report writing through our topic. We will continue to build on our vocabulary through spelling and Daily Write activities, continuing to develop sentence structure, paragraphing, use of a variety of punctuation and vocabulary.

**Talking & Listening:** We will further develop our attention and listening skills through note making, body language and presentation skills by delivering our book reviews and research to the class.



### NUMERACY

In numeracy and Maths we will take part in a variety of class, interactive, group and individual activities.

This term there will be a focus on multiplication and division facts, fractions, time, money and handling data.

We will continue to consolidate our written addition and subtraction skills as well as our mental strategies and response speed when working out mental calculations.

### LEARNING ACROSS THE CURRICULUM

This term our interdisciplinary learning topic will be 'Around the World' where we compare countries such as France, Japan and India to Scotland. We will continue our work on Eco Schools and maintaining our Green Flag status alongside P6J.

In expressive arts we will focus on 3D sculpture using the Eiffel Tower and Taj Mahal as our inspiration. We will also look at Japanese Anime and traditional art using a variety of media.

In RME we will be exploring the Jewish traditions of Shabbat.
