In PE we will be taking part in different athletic and Commonwealth sports. P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday.

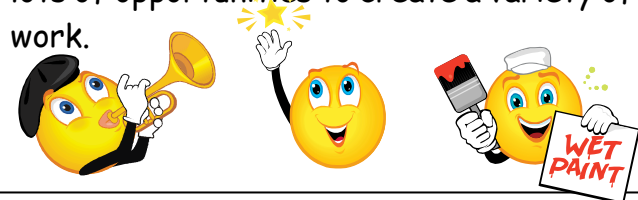


Expressive Arts

Drama - Our topic will create a focus to develop skills in presenting, improvising, miming and acting.

Music - We will be developing skills in playing a short piece of music using tuned percussion.

Art - We will develop our skills of using different mediums to create artwork for a specific purpose. Our topic will create lots of opportunities to create a variety of work.



Numeracy

This term our main focus will be multiplying and dividing by 7,8 and 9.

We will be learning about 5-minute intervals in time and telling the time on both analogue and digital clocks.

We will be estimating and measuring weight.

We will also look at different types of graphs and charts and how to collate and present data we have found.



Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our reading and comprehension skills through group books, novels and literature circle tasks.

Writing - Our focus this term is participating in the writing project. We will focus on developing tools for writing including openers, interesting vocabulary and punctuation. We will complete daily writing tasks. We will also develop skills in self-assessing and self-correcting our work.



Talking and Listening - We will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. We will be continuing to develop our skills in active listening.

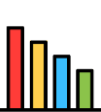


Topic - Our topic this term will be "The Commonwealth Games". We will research the background to the games as well as exploring the countries of the commonwealth.
