Health and Wellbeing:



Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Thursday. We will focus on athletics and summer games.

We will focus on how physical activity & sport can lead to positive destinations beyond school. We will also look at the negative impact bullying has on others and work on ways to be more inclusive,

Outdoor learning will take place every Monday. Please ensure appropriate clothing and footwear is worn. We will be learning about mapping and exploring our local environment.

Expressive Arts:

Music and Drama - We will develop our music and drama skills together whilst learning about countries of the Commonwealth and their cultures.



Art - We will continue to learn about the elements of Art, focusing on line and texture. We will also learn the history of stained glass and use art skills to recreate stained glass pictures.



Homework

Homework will be issued on Learning Journals on a Monday. This should be returned by the end of the week.

Numeracy:

We will continue to enhance our skills in the four functions, using these to solve BODMAS equations.

Pupils will also work to ensure times table knowledge and recall is faster and more accurate.



Maths



We will be learning about fractions, decimals and percentages and the links between these.

We will also revisit using analogue and digital clocks to tell time to the nearest minute.

French:

Our French lessons will focus on the parts of the body and following instructions with what to do with our bodies.

Literacy:

Reading - This term we will continue to develop our reading comprehension skills through SHORS and group reading materials.

Writing - This term, we will be learning about the features of narrative texts. Pupils will focus on verb tense and using adjectives to build interesting pieces of writing. We will also be developing our spelling skills by investigating different letter patterns/sounds. Daily opportunities for writing will also continue.

Talking and Listening - We will research and deliver a short presentation linked to our topic. We will also develop our Oracy skills.



Topic

Our topic this term will be the Commonwealth and the Commonwealth Games. We will find out about many of the countries included in the Commonwealth. We will also have a go at some of the sports included in the Commonwealth Games during PE lessons.

ICT:

In ICT, we will be developing our skills to manipulate texts and images using a variety of software. These will be used during class presentations.



Science:

This term we will be working alongside Glasgow Science Centre to learn about Our Amazing Air. Pupils will investigate what air is and why it is so important, what air pollution is and how we monitor it and learn how air quality can be improved.

RME:

In RME we will be learning about famous Christians. Pupils will find out what a saint is and discover facts about famous saints.
