### Health and Wellbeing

Our focus this term is on our developing bodies. We will look at the physical and emotional changes taking place in line with our developing hormones.

In P.E., we will focus upon a range of athletics disciplines and play summer games.

### Numeracy

This term, Primary 6 will develop their skills and abilities to select and apply mental strategies to solve problems focussing on multiplication and division. Primary 6 will continue to build on their knowledge of percentages as they develop an awareness of budgeting and affordability, whilst carrying out different money calculations.



### Literacy

**Reading** – This term we will continue to develop our ability to use monitoring strategies in relation to progress our pace and confidence in front of a small audience. We will look to answer complex inferential and evaluative questions using an array of different texts.

**Writing** – Our focus this term shall be completing our information reports and narrative texts. We will use the Steven Graham approach to explore genre and develop our writing skills. Primary 6 will also look to improve and use spelling strategies and use of grammar to up-level our writing.

**Talking and Listening** – Through our Oracy skills, Primary 6 will focus on active listening and communicating effectively with a partner or as part of a small group or debate.



### Context for Learning

This term we will be learning about the Scottish Parliament. We will use this as a context for our learning across the curriculum as we build up our knowledge and understanding.

### Science

Primary 6 will investigate processes of the human body and how to stay healthy.

### RME

We will explore the religious practice of pilgrimage in different religions such as Christianity, Islam and Judaism.

### Digital Technologies

This term we will be developing our digital literacy in relation to features and functions of different types of software that can support daily learning. We will also look to access GLOW for file saving and sharing.



### Expressive Arts

**Drama** – We will explore the use of character roles using voice and movement skills and how these can relate to a small audience.

**Music** – We will continue to explore a range of instruments and how they can be used to create different sounds, mood and atmosphere.

**Art** – We will be observing more complex patterns in nature, science and maths, whilst considering various artists creations of pattern, as we discuss their effects.
