Health and Wellbeing

Our gym days will be Wednesdays and Fridays this term. We will be developing our balancing skills. We will be balancing along equipment such as benches, balancing boards and balancing beams. We will also be developing our cardio skills through running games and whilst using the trikes. During Health and Wellbeing lessons, we will be progressing an awareness of sharing resources.



Literacy



This term we will be exploring the story 'Super Worm' by Julia Donaldson. We will develop sequencing skills during literacy lessons. We will also be engaging in role play activities related to 'Super Worm' and Minibeasts. Whilst exploring the story, we will also be developing an awareness of characterisation.

Numeracy



Term 4 will see us move onto encountering symmetry in the environment around us. We will be exploring reflections using mirrors and other reflective objects. Whilst exploring symmetry, we will be developing our skills in matching symmetrical pictures and finding the missing half of a symmetrical picture.

Outdoor Learning



During Term 4 we will be exploring 'Minibeasts' as our topic during Outdoor Learning. We will be using resources such as magnifying glasses and nets to have a closer look at insects in their natural environment. We will also have the opportunity to explore the natural areas out with the school gates such as the forest behind the school. Please ensure pupils have sun cream in their bags to keep their skin safe during Outdoor Learning lessons.



Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we will be developing an awareness of how to stay safe during warmer weather. We will be exploring the importance of staying hydrated when it is warm outside. We will also develop an awareness of the importance of protecting our skin during sunny weather by wearing appropriate clothes such as a sun hat and wearing sunscreen.
