Health and Wellbeing

We have gym on a Monday and Tuesday this year so please make sure pupil have a kit in their bag or at school. In PE, children will develop movement skills such as running, jumping, balancing, throwing, and catching. They will build coordination, confidence, and an understanding of how to move safely using equipment. They will learn simple class routines, such as taking turns and shared attention. They will build positive relationships by building bonds with staff and getting to know their peers through play.



Literacy



Reading - Pupils will enjoy familiar nursery rhymes to develop listening, attention, and communication skills. They will join in with sounds, actions, and repeated words.

Writing - Children will explore mark making using pencils, crayons, paint, and other materials. They will develop early writing skills through drawing, scribbling, and making simple shapes and lines.

Talking and Listening - We will develop communication skills using gestures, facial expressions, objects, pictures, signs, and communication aids. They will practise expressing their needs, choices, feelings, and interests in ways that work for them.

Numeracy

We will be exploring numbers that we encounter in our environment. We will have opportunities to explore numbers beyond 10. During our school day we will be encouraged to count, sequence and order numbers within a range appropriate to individuals. We will have the opportunity to explore shape and colour through play and different activities.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Children will explore castles through stories, pictures, songs, and play. They will learn simple facts about castles and explore features such as towers, walls, drawbridges, and flags. We use a book study to aid our understanding of castles using 'The Knight Who Said "No!"' by Lucy Rowland.



Outdoor Learning



Children will explore the outdoors and learn about moving safely between different activities and places. They will develop an understanding of wearing suitable clothing for different weather conditions. We will explore the outdoor environment through play, movement, and sensory activities. They will develop curiosity, confidence, and awareness of the world around them.
