Health and Wellbeing

Our Health and Wellbeing learning will focus on building positive relationships. Through a range of engaging activities and discussions, pupils will develop their communication skills.

P.E

This term in PE we are developing our teamwork and cooperation skills through netball, while also building our agility and balance.

P.E. days are Monday and Friday.



Expressive Arts

Drama - Through our topic, pupils will develop their improvisation and role-play skills.

Music - We will develop our listening and music skills by exploring and responding to a variety of music.

Art - Our topic will provide opportunities for the children to develop their knowledge and skills in colour mixing and shading.



Numeracy

This term, we will focus on strengthening our understanding and confidence in the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.



In addition, we will be exploring the properties of 2D, and 3D shape, before investigating symmetry and identifying symmetrical patterns and shapes in a variety of contexts.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will develop our comprehension skills by exploring a variety of engaging texts, including our class novel 'Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing'. Working in groups and independently, children will build their confidence and understanding of SHORS.

Writing - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the key features of descriptive writing, including using effective openers and connectives.

Talking and Listening - We will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. We will be developing our skills in active listening.



Topic

This term, our topic will be Natural Disasters. We will explore a range of weather phenomenon and seismic activities.

Pupils will work collaboratively and share their findings with the rest of the class.

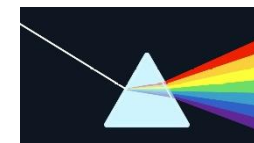


RME
