Health and Wellbeing



Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Friday.

We will focus on team games and working together.

As part of Health and Wellbeing we will be learning about The Rights of the Child to create our class charter. We will also explore positive relationships and personal hygiene.

Expressive Arts

Music -



We will identify the different instruments used to compose a piece of music that represent a variety of emotions.

Art -

Drama -



We will use our class novel 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' as a stimulus. We will be focusing on talking with expression when taking on the role of a specific character.

Maths : This term we will be strengthening our mental maths skills by focusing on key strategies in class lessons. We will also focus on revisiting the 4 number processes and complete a variety of activities around these. P5/4 will also explore place value and estimating and rounding.



RME : This term we will focus on the special buildings linked to different religions. We will learn about the key features of a Synagogue and what happens in a Mosque.

Science : We will be naming and identifying different parts of a plant. We will also grow our own plants.

Literacy

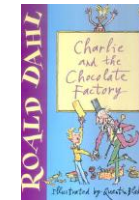
Reading - This term we will further develop our reading comprehension skills through our topic novel 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' and our PM reading books. We will also explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies.

Writing - This term we will be revisiting descriptive writing linked to our topic of 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We will also explore sentence structure and punctuation.

Talking and Listening - We will develop our listening and talking skills through a variety of attention and listening games and activities. We will focus on being able to take turns to speak and asking our peers questions.

Topic

We will be reading the novel 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl. We will be developing our comprehension skills through a variety of activities. We will also link our descriptive writing to the novel. As part of our topic we will look at the origins of chocolate and how it is made as well as exploring Fairtrade.
