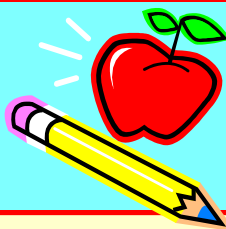

Mathematics & Numeracy

Measurement – Length – We have been learning how to measure using cm and m (up to 1.5m)

2D shapes and 3D objects – We have been learning about tessellation.

Number & Number Process – We will be learning to multiply by 2, 5 and 10 with opportunities to explore links with different multiplication tables.

Data & Analysis – We will be conducting surveys and creating bar graphs.

Angle, Symmetry & Transformation – We will be learning how to describe journeys using instructions.

* Zones of Regulation – Creating toolkit for self-regulation. .

Expressive Arts

* Art: We will be using Art to support our learning about the Maya Civilization.

* Drama: We will be using our voice and creativity during games and exercises.

Technologies & Science

* Science: We will be focusing our learning on forces.

* ICT: Coding through Minecraft and the use of apps to support learning across curriculum.

Literacy & Languages

* Spelling: Phonics recognition, spelling common words independently using various active spelling strategies.

* Reading: SHORS strategies – Visualising – using visualising to aid our understanding of what we have read. Learning the features of and how to use non-fiction texts. Group reading using Rigby Star books with follow-up comprehension tasks. Class novel – James and the Giant Peach.

* Writing: Imaginative writing with a focus on using connectives to improve our sentence structure and checking the correct punctuation is used. Developing our use of interesting adjectives. Functional writing – writing information reports ensuring we include the key features of this style of text.

* Talking & Listening: Active Listening skills – answering questions after listening to a text – justifying our opinions – turn taking when talking in pairs and as part of a group.

* French: Classroom nouns and weather.
