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Mathematics & Numeracy

Exploring number patterns and continuing number sequences, explaining the rule applied. Solving addition and subtraction problems by looking for a pattern. Finding right angles in shapes and following instructions – turn left, forward, etc. Learning to use bar graphs and tally marks. Making and counting amounts of money using coins up to 50p and using money to pay for items. Ordering the months of the year and matching occasions to months of the year. Learning to estimate lengths and measure length in metres and half metres.

Health & Wellbeing

P.E.: Gymnastics. Dance. Fitness (Circuit Training).

Wellbeing: Developing our ability to identify and manage our emotions. Building resilience. Food and health.

Expressive Arts

Art: Exploring a variety of media to create visually interesting artwork. Incorporating knowledge of other curricular areas. Topic related activities.

Drama: Role play in our classroom and outside linked to our topic and health and wellbeing. Performing to an audience.

Music: Listening to a range of genres of music from around the world. Exploring different musicians and composers.

Technologies & Science

Science: My Day, Month and Year.

Technologies: Interactive white board and iPads to navigate educational games. Creating instructions for technology using Bee-Bots. Understanding functions of a browser and search engine.

Literacy & Languages

Reading: Rigby Star reading books and related activities. Practising reading our key words daily. Continuing with phonics programme to develop our spelling, reading and writing skills.

Writing: Encouraging independent writing and developing our confidence to sound out new words. Learning to spell the most commonly used words correctly. Correct use of punctuation and using finger spaces when writing in sentences. Learning to use connectives. Continuing our PM Writing scheme to explore different genres of writing.

Talking & Listening: Developing our skills through small group/paired discussion activities. Performing our Scots poem to an audience.

French: Body parts. Family. Weather.

RME: Stories of caring and sharing in Judaism.

Social Studies: Scotland & Dinosaurs.
