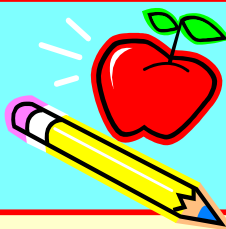

Mathematics & Numeracy

Number & Number Process – Dividing by 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10.

Fractions, Decimals & Percentages – Identifying fractions and finding a fraction of an amount.

Angles, Symmetry & Transformation – using co-ordinate grids and plotting points. We will also be learning to use a compass.

Estimating and Rounding – Rounding numbers to the nearest 10. Estimating answers using rounded numbers.

Multiplication tables and number bonds.

Literacy & Languages

* Spelling: Phonics recognition, spelling common words independently using various active spelling strategies.

* Reading: SHORS strategies – learning about inference and monitoring our understanding as we read. Learning to use expression when reading aloud. Group reading using Rigby Star books with follow-up comprehension tasks. Class novels – The Sleekit Mr Tod (Fantastic Mr Fox written in Scots) and Nim's Island.

* Writing: Imaginative writing with a focus on openers to vary the start of our sentences and checking the correct punctuation is used including question marks and exclamation marks. Developing our use of interesting words. Functional writing – writing recounts and information reports ensuring we include the key features of these styles of text.

* Talking & Listening: Active Listening skills – creating questions after listening to a text. Learning about Scots dialect and performing The Sair Finger.

Health & Wellbeing

* PE: Gymnastics, Dance, Hockey and Fitness Circuits. Our PE days are Tuesdays with Mrs Caldwell and Fridays with Mr Blair.

* Treehouse – we will be using this resource to support our mental, social and emotional wellbeing.

* Food & Health – we will be learning about food hygiene and preparing some simple recipes.

* Outdoor learning – we will be continuing to complete different activities during our outdoor learning sessions on Wednesday afternoons with a focus on teamwork and problem solving. Some of these will also be STEM challenges.
