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Mathematics & Numeracy

Literacy & Languages

* **Spelling:** Each group will have a list of spelling words to learn at home and in class weekly using written and active tasks. There will also be a focus of common words linked to age and stage of your children to use throughout writing sessions in the class.

* **Reading:** Each child works from either the Rigby Star, Literacy world or novels. Children will have a book in class then the following week have it or identified chapters as homework to share their successes at home. SHORS strategies of inference and summarizing this term will be the focus.

***Writing:** Recount, Procedural, imaginative, discussion and poetry. Children will have opportunities to plan and write a variety of genres of writing. Throughout writing children will also receive opportunities to use grammar skills learnt within the class.

* **Talking & Listening:** active listening tasks will be completed weekly as well as skills used during drama. Presenting skills will also be developed this term. Also a Scots poem will be learned

* **French:** This term the class will be learning numbers to 10, classroom objects and food types. . .
