Mathematics & Numeracy

Addition and subtraction to 10. We shall be building upon our mental calculation skills and developing our knowledge of number stories (ways to make 3/4/5...etc.).

Measuring and comparing capacities in non-standard units and using the language of capacity, e.g., full, nearly full, empty.

Numbers to 20 – ordering, recording and finding missing numbers. Exploring odd and even numbers.

Problem Solving – We shall be 'solving mysteries' by applying all of our mathematical knowledge in logical ways.

Ordinal numbers – exploring ordinal numbers in real life settings / scenarios.

Literacy & Languages

Phonics: Continuing to learn our digraphs (when two letters get together to make one sound, e.g. 'oi') and beginning to focus upon blends (blending two consonants together, e.g. pl / br / st).

Reading: Rigby Star reading books and related activities. Practising reading our key words and introducing new words. Applying our reading skills for reading information activities, such as 'read and draw'. Using simple contents / index page to find information. Exploring non-fiction texts.

Writing: continuing to encourage independent writing and developing confidence to attempt spelling words, using all we know. Learning to spell our tricky, commonly used words. Writing longer pieces (more than one sentence) alongside the correct use of full stop and capital letter.

Listening and talking: developing our conversational skills and our ability to be a good listener. Talking with others to solve problems. Talking about our feelings. Show and Tell – talking about an object from home to our class.

Social Studies:

Under the Sea, including personal research project (information to follow).

Stories of caring and sharing in Islam.

Health & Wellbeing

P.E.: Athletics and Summer games.

Wellbeing: Relationships, managing emotions, hygienic practices.

Expressive Arts

Art: Undertaking topic-based art and crafts. Modelling and creating 3D objects using a variety of materials.

Drama: Imaginative role play in our house corner. Expressing our thoughts, feelings and understanding through our own dramatic representations of stories we have listened to.

Music: Using percussion. Exploring pulse and rhythm.

Technologies & Science

Technologies:

Word processing, including opening and closing a pre-saved file.

Science: We shall be exploring 'Living Things', with a special focus upon plant life.

STEM challenges – working with others to solve problems by applying the principles of engineering.
