Mathematics & Numeracy

Number & Number Processes – Addition and subtraction using 3 digits.

Length – $\frac{1}{2}$ metres and $\frac{1}{4}$ metres.

Number & Number Processes – Multiplication – two digit by one digit multiplication problems.

Number & Number Processes – Addition and subtraction – calculating change from £10.00.

Number bonds and problem solving.

Literacy & Languages

* Spelling: using various active spelling strategies to identify patterns and spell common words independently.

* Reading: SHORS strategies – learning about prediction before we read a text. Learning to use a dictionary. Taking short notes. Group reading using Rigby Star books with follow-up comprehension tasks. Class novel – Akimbo and the Elephants.

* Writing: Functional writing – writing recounts ensuring we include the key features of this style of text. Imaginative writing with a focus on openers to vary the start of our sentences and checking the correct punctuation is used. Continuing to develop our use of interesting words. Introducing peer reviewing.

* Talking & Listening: Active Listening skills – identifying facts and opinions in a text – having a debate – creating questions after listening to a text.

* French: animals, weather.

Health & Wellbeing

* PE: Athletics, Tennis and summer games. Our PE days continue to be Tuesdays with Mrs Caldwell and Fridays with Mr Blair.

* Treehouse – we will be using this resource to support our mental, social and emotional wellbeing.

* Relationships – we will be learning about what makes a good friend.

* Outdoor learning – we will be continuing to complete different activities during our outdoor learning sessions on Wednesday afternoons with a focus on teamwork and problem solving.
