Can my Parents/Carers come too?

Parents/Carers are welcome to bring children into school on the first morning. Parents/Carers will also have the opportunity to come into class and take your photo.

After that, Primary 1 pupils will line up at the door in their Houses. Your House colour will be red (Cuff), blue (Bigholm) or yellow (Spiers). The older children will help you.

Soon you will want to walk into school from the school gate on your own.

Children usually settle down quickly as soon as (upset!) parents/carers leave.



What should I wear?

Our school uniform is:

- navy skirt/trousers/pinafore
- pale blue polo shirt or white/pale blue shirt & tie
- navy jumper/sweatshirt
- navy or black shoes

What should I bring?

- P1-3 lunch is free
- P.E. Kit (in a small drawstring bag that can be left on school peg) - indoor shoes, navy shorts, pale blue polo shirt.
- NO jewellery should be worn.
(We advise if you wish to pierce your child's ears, please do so in the summer holidays as earrings **must** be removed for gym.)
- A **small snack** for playtime.
- A **water bottle** that can be refilled in school. (No Flavoured Water or Juice)



All clothing and property should be clearly labelled. We don't want unnamed items disappearing without trace!

What will I do at break?

Primary 6/7 pupils will be asked to keep a watchful eye on the new P1s for a few days.

We also operate a Buddy System where they support each other in the playground. You will receive a personal message from your buddy in the near future.

After a short while you will no doubt want to play with your friends.



Please make sure you have suitable wet weather clothes since it is much better to play outside unless the weather is very bad.

If the weather is really bad then you are able to stay in class and be supervised by older pupils and staff.

Our Janitor, Mrs Cairns, Classroom Assistant, Mrs McGowan or Mrs Coia at the office are always there to help in case of accidents.

We are a health promoting school so encourage everyone to bring a healthy snack e.g. fruit, small sandwich, cheese, raisins. Please keep sweet treats/crisps as part of your balanced packed lunch or for home.



The Pencil Hold Rap


- Pick up your pencil - use your pointer and thumb,


We have an open evening in September to allow you to see what your child has been working on. This will be confirmed nearer the time and may be dependent on the current circumstances relating to covid-19.

There are usually 3 Learning Conversations throughout the year to review your child's progress with the class teacher. We always welcome the children along to these too.


Parents are welcome to visit the school at other times. If a longer interview is needed, it is best to call the school office and make an appointment.

q	Take off, reverse around the queen's necklace, up, down, flick.
r	Take off, up, down the red rose, over the red rose.
s	Take off and swish through the sky.
t	Take off, up, down the tree trunk, flick and across the branches.
u	Take off, up, into the umbrella, up, down and flick.
w	Take off, down the wase, up the wase, flick.
m	Take off, mom, waves, mom, waves, flick.
x	Take off, x marks the spot.
y	Take off, up, down like a yoyo, up like a yoyo, swing like a yoyo.
z	Take off, zoom, zap, zoom.
