Reading

We will be focusing on developing our NAC reading strategies: visualising, summarising, inferring, predicting, monitoring, summarising and questioning. We will focus on developing our comprehension skills and using information from the text to help us answer a range of questions. 📖

Grammar

We will focus on description through adverbs, adjectives and up-levelling sentences. ✎

Talking & Listening

We are excited to develop these skills through our daily organisation, daily news and presentations. To demonstrate an understanding of what I have listened to and be able to ask and answer a range of questions (literal, evaluative and inferential). 🗣️

Writing

We will be focusing on writing a description this term through our PM writing resource. We will also engage in writing relating to our topic such as a persuasive advert, newspaper article and recounts in the form of a diary entry and a letter. ✎

Numeracy & Mathematics

Numeracy: Number and Place Value

We will focus on reading, writing and partitioning numbers, multiplication and division strategies, BODMAS, finding factor pairs and multiples and choosing the correct strategy to solve a number problem. We will focus on mental maths and discussing our strategies through daily number talks.

Mathematics: Shape, position and

movement. We will be able to identify properties of shapes. We will recognise, classify and measure a range of angles. We will describe points on a compass, record routes and investigate scale.

Topic- The Titanic

Our topic this term will have a history focus. We will be investigating the construction of the Titanic, the passengers and crew, the events leading to the sinking, the rescue attempts and the enquiry. 🚢

STEM- we will be complete experiments relating to our Titanic topic exploring buoyancy, states of matter, density and salinity. 🧪

Expressive Arts

In music we will be focusing on our performance skills through learning glockenspiel. We will also develop our listening skills and identifying parts of the orchestra. We will also complete a range of art in relation to our Titanic topic.

ICT: With our new SeeSaw app, we will explore creating and sending work digitally and communicating through email. We will also focus on online safety. 🧑
