Emails/letters will continue for consent to attend clubs etc. and Xpressions messages or texts will be used for urgent information or quick updates.

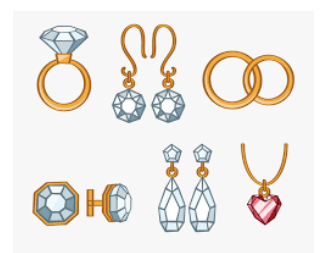
