Dear Parent/Carer,

Whole School Trip - Culzean Castle

As per the letter you received, this year the whole school will be visiting Culzean castle on Wednesday 21st June. Can we remind families that children can't travel to Culzean on a bus without a returned AV5 form with a parent/carer signature. If you require a new form please contact the school office.

We have had some enquiries from families offering to pay for the trip or make a donation to school funds. Unfortunately we can't always presume to know which families may be in financial difficulties for different reasons e.g. losing a job, losing a business, increase in mortgage, and which families have no difficulties. Therefore the trip has been made free for all for equity reasons. As per your suggestion, there will be a collection at the Church Service on the last day of school for families wishing to make a contribution to school funds. You can do this in person or send some money with your child. There is no obligation to contribute.

Please remember packed lunches will be provided for all children in Primary 1 to 5 and those in receipt of free school meals. Children bringing their own packed lunch should do so in a paper/plastic bag that can be put in the bin after lunch. This saves children carrying the bag around all day. Please write your child's name on their bag and please ensure that there are no nut products included in your child's lunch or snack due to allergies.

If you are providing your own packed lunch for your child please select the packed lunch option on the iPayimpact lunch ordering system so the catering team doesn't include these children when making up orders.
