### Captain and Vice Captains 2023/2024

Our P7s are busy preparing speeches to be the House Captain or Vice-Captain of their house. At Glebe we have 4 houses, Fennick, Lugton, Annick and Garnock. Every child at Glebe is part of a house. They earn points and tokens for their house. Listen out for your children telling you all about this!

#### Wider Achievement

Our P7 House Captains and Vice Captains help lead the assemblies and encourage the children to earn points for their house. We will continue to celebrate the children's wider achievement at the end of the Friday assembly. Children who have earned certificates, medals, trophies or other achievements out of school, should bring them to school on a Friday. The House Captains and Vice Captains will ensure their photos are recorded in our Awesome Achievements book, and more importantly points are earned for their house!

### **Senior Leadership Team Certificates**

Children also earn Head Teacher/Depute Head Teacher certificates for excellent work/progress/effort in class. Children with excellent work will visit the DHT/HT to share this work. Over the course of their time at Glebe children will work towards bronze, silver, gold and then diamond certificates. Look out for certificates in school bags this session.

### **School Forms/letters**

Annual data, medical, local journey and photograph consent forms are in schoolbags today. We ask families to check the information is accurate and update any inaccuracies, before signing and returning to the office. The importance of having up to date contact details can't be stressed highly enough. We had real difficulty contacting some families in emergency situations last session.

Please note your child will not be able to go on any trips including local trips, e.g. the library or have their photograph taken, e.g. P1 annual newspaper photo, without completed consent forms. We can't use last session's forms.

### PE Uniform

Please remember that we now have a standard PE uniform which can be worn to school, on the PE days below. PE uniform must be in school colours consisting of the following;

- Dark/plain leggings, shorts or jogging bottoms.
- Polo shirt and school jumper/cardigan/hoodie.

## Attendance and late coming

We are continuing to focus on improving attendance and late coming across the school. Every school day counts and we want to work with families who experience barriers to attendance.

We also ask for your support to get children to school on time as children who are regularly late miss vital chunks of leaning every day. We appreciate the many families who are very supportive of the school's work in these areas.

## Homework

Last session we changed homework based on parental feedback. Unfortunately, homework continues to be a concern at Glebe due to the quality of the work returned and the lack of pupils completing homework tasks. We will continue to issue homework on a Friday to be returned for the following Thursday. This will start on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September. Homework will consist of spelling, reading and maths. Spelling tasks will be related to class work taught that week, reading books will be issued for infants whereas older pupils will be issued library books to focus on reading for enjoyment. Maths tasks will focus on revising key skills. We invite parents/carers who are interested in working with us to review homework to get in touch. Let us know if you would like to be involved.





### Lunch

Lunch is free for all P1-P5 pupils and those in receipt of the free school meals and clothing grant.

We would encourage your child to take advantage of this and the lunches are varied, healthy and saves families time and money making packed lunches. We also appreciate families taking the time to discuss food options and then preordering lunch to reduce the time class teachers spend on this task daily, which, I'm sure you can imagine can take up valuable learning and teaching time.

### Flu Immunisations

All pupils will be eligible to receive the flu immunisation (nose puff) on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October. Consent letters are in schoolbags today and should be returned ASAP as NHS staff will collect the forms on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September. Please be aware your child will not receive their immunisation unless the letter is received and processed by the NHS as per the above timescales.



### P1 and P7 Dental Inspections

The NHS Dental team will be in school on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October to carry out the annual P1 and P7 dental inspections. Letters will follow with specific information for those year groups.

# Learning Café

In order to share what your child is learning in class we are introducing Learning Cafés on the first Friday of the month (or first Friday in the new term) starting next Friday 1<sup>st</sup> September. This will also be an opportunity for you to meet your child's new teacher.

### What is a Learning Café?

This is an opportunity for you to visit your child's class, see their work and participate in a child led activity. Each café will have a different theme. E.g. the first one will be play based.

### Who is invited?

Parents, carers, grandparents...it's up to you. However, due to capacity and classroom space we would ask that only one person attends each session (as there are lots over the year). For Health and Safety reasons prams/buggies are not permitted. These can be left in the gym hall.

### When?

### Time?

We are splitting the afternoon into 3 sessions in order to reduce the number of people in each class at any one time which should help the sessions run smoothly. Therefore we are arranging session alphabetically by surname.

- 1<sup>st</sup> session 1.15-1.45pm families with surnames starting with A through to H
- 2<sup>nd</sup> session 1.45-2.15pm- families with surnames starting with I through to M
- 3<sup>rd</sup> session 2.15-2.45pm- families with surnames starting with N through to Z

If you have more than one child at Glebe then please choose different sessions for your other children to ensure you get quality time with each of them.

Myself and Mr Wilson will be available at the Learning Cafés should you wish to discuss anything. We hope you are excited to join us on these dates and hope to see a good turnout of parents/carers across the entire school. Furthermore, please note there will be other opportunities for you to engage with your child's learning throughout the year. E.g. Learning Conversations/Parents' Evenings, Curricular Workshops, School Shows, Infant Nativity, Church Services, Family Learning Events, PTA/PC Events and School Trips.

Apologies for the families who missed this morning's Play and Stay- there seems to have been an issue with the sign up link.


There has been another session organised for next Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August from 2-3pm. Further dates will follow for those who are unable to make the first two dates.

This session there will be two written reports and two Learning Conversations with you, your child and the Class Teacher.


