### Wonderful World Book Day! by Violet

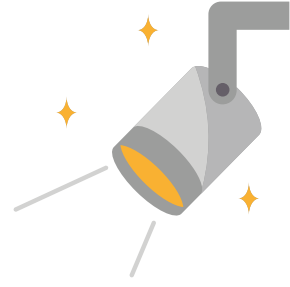

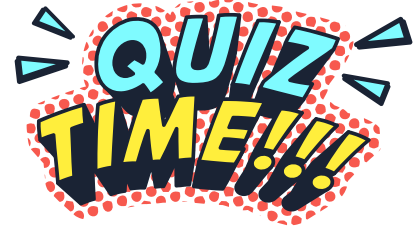
