Parents/Carers Meeting

Parents/Carers are invited to attend an initial meeting with the Head Teacher and Principal Teacher without their children. This allows parents/carers to be given information about the school, complete any necessary forms and ask any questions they may have.

Indoor/Outdoor Activity Session

Children will be given the opportunity to spend two short sessions at school with other children attending Glebe Primary in August.

This will allow your child to experience the routine of P1 and the Infant Department environment. Your child will join with the P1 children and work with infant staff on short tasks, stories and games.

Teddy Bear's Picnic

Your child is invited to come to Glebe Primary for some games, songs and activities in the playground; or in the hall if the weather is poor. Please bring along a special teddy or soft toy to join us at the picnic. Our current P1 pupils will be with us to provide 'Buddy' support to our new children, as well as P5 pupils who will be next year's P6 Wellbeing Warriors. Children will be offered a small snack of crisps, biscuits and a drink.

School Lunch taster

Parents/carers are invited to join us at 11.45am in order for children to try a school lunch in the school dining hall.

Bump Up Transition Afternoon

On this day your child will be invited to arrive at school for 1.30pm. The children will spend time in the class, which they will be in when they attend school in August and spend the afternoon with their new class teacher. They will experience the routine of the class and go out for break in the playground.
