In response to parental requests, we will be implementing a new online booking system for appointments. This system will go live Friday

We truly hope you can join us for the evening and encourage you to bring your child along, as it's important for them to engage in discussions about their learning. If you'd like to speak with the teacher privately, your child can step out for a moment while you have that conversation.

Book Week Scotland is an annual celebration of books and reading that takes place across the country. Book Week Scotland 2024 takes place from Monday 18th to Friday 22nd November- look out for events and activities in your local area.

We invite parents and carers to join us from 2:15 PM on Monday, November 18th, for the launch of the P1 Book Bug, P2 Read Write Count, and P3 Read Write Count bags.

School staff will demonstrate how to use these resources and books to support children at home. Afterwards, parents and carers will have the opportunity to spend time with their children exploring the contents before going home.









As we work together to foster healthy habits in our school community, we'd love your help in supporting the return to smaller or healthier snacks for your child during school breaks.
