College Provision *(Subject to confirmation by Ayrshire College)*

There are a variety of school college courses available and are provisional dependent on numbers and staff availability from the college. These courses will be populated by pupils from other schools therefore a limited number of places may be available to Greenwood Academy pupils. The college will also be undertaking a **selection process** and pupils will have to complete an **application** and be **interviewed**.
