

SOME TIPS ON REFLECTIVE WRITING FOR PUPILS

In general, pupils find it difficult to reflect on what they have done. They are good at describing a task, but not evaluating it or looking at how they should improve upon it next time. The steps below may be useful to use with pupils when writing posts.

1. Describe what you did.

3. What do you need to do to improve?

Next time I need to.....

4. What skills did you develop/learn.

I feel I have developed my communication skills because.....

5. Your conclusion should be positive.

I really enjoyed....and can't wait to do it again.
