

FOLLOWING PUPILS' BLOGS


It is now possible to 'follow' pupil blogs and have their latest posts displayed in your dashboard, eliminating the need to visit every pupil's blog to check if they have made a post. Start the process either by visiting every child's blog and clicking on the **follow** star at the top of the screen or clicking the star beside their name on your list of sites.




You will see a message at the top of the blog to say you are now following it:




Once you have followed all your pupils' blogs, you should go to your own blog and click on **Blogs I Follow**. You will see this page.




Click on the **Blogs** tab to see your list of pupils.




You can sort pupils into different groups or simply allocate them to your class by clicking on the **Blog Groups** tab. Enter your group name eg. **Primary 7** and click **Create Group**




You will then see your group displayed as below.



To allocate pupils to your class/group(s), return to the **Blogs** tab, tick the box beside the pupils' names and choose their class/group from the dropdown box as below.



Now when the blog posts are displayed, they are arranged by class — simply pick your group/class from the dropdown box to view.



You can view the actual posts by clicking on the name of the post. This will take you to the pupil's blog. To return to your blog, choose your name from **My Sites** at the top left side.
