What we've been up to...

Work to develop our school gardens and grounds has continued. A big thank you to all of the pupils and parents that have helped.

Similarly, our Eco Committee have been unable to meet in the regular way. However, members have managed to hold some mini meetings within their year group bubbles. We are determined to continue our very important environmental work as best we can, despite current challenges and restrictions.
