

Term: Term 1

Literacy

Session: 2025-2026

Health & Wellbeing

We will be continuing to work on single sounds and building CVC words (three-letter words such as cat and dog). The children will have opportunities to practise these skills in both reading and writing. In writing, we will be focusing on personal stories, encouraging the children to write simple sentences about their own experiences, remembering to use capital letters and full stops. We will also do lots of talking and listening activities to help build confidence in sharing ideas and using new vocabulary.

We will be learning about feelings, kindness, and working together as a team. We will be using the SHANAR-RI wellbeing indicators (Safe, Healthy, Achieving, Nurtured, Active, Respected, Responsible, Included) to help the children reflect on how to look after themselves and others.

Social Studies

Our Social Studies work will be based on the story The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. We will be finding out about lighthouses, looking at life by the sea, and using maps to explore coastlines. We will also be learning about where our food comes from and how it travels to our plates.

Maths & Numeracy

In Maths, our focus will be on place value, helping the children to understand tens and ones as we work with numbers up to 100. We will be practising addition and using different strategies to build our mental maths skills. Later in the term, we will also be exploring 2D shapes, learning their names and properties, and using them to make patterns.

STEM

In STEM, we are learning about electricity. The children will explore how electricity is used at home and at school, and will try out simple circuits using batteries, wires, and bulbs. We will also be discussing how to stay safe when using electricity.

Modern Languages

In French, the children will be practising greetings, numbers to ten, and colours, as well as learning some new words that we can use in the classroom. We will sing and enjoy some French songs.

Expressive Arts

In Expressive Arts, we will be exploring patterns, observational drawing, and printing, using a variety of materials. We will also link some of our art, drama, and music activities to our lighthouse topic to help bring the story to life in creative ways. In PE, the focus this term will be on developing skills with small equipment. The children will have opportunities to practise control, balance, and coordination through activities using beanbags, quoits, hoops, and other equipment.

Digital Technologies

in RME, the children will be learning about Christianity in RME by exploring the story of Baby Moses, we will be thinking about the themes of family, care, and protection.

Through Technologies, we will focus on using digital devices safely. We will discuss what information should not be shared online and who children can turn to for help. The children will also use simple software to support their learning.
