

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be continuously learning and revising spelling patterns to help improve our spelling across all curricular areas. Within writing lessons, we will be working to enhance our writing by using a greater variety of connectives. We will be extending our knowledge of grammar by learning about the use of various punctuation and applying this in our writing. We will also be consolidating our use of joined up handwriting. This term, we will be reading a class novel entitled 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' by Onjali Rauf and will be working on various SHORS strategies to further develop our comprehension skills.

In PE, we will be developing our hockey skills and our general fitness through circuits. Those chosen for the Athletics Team will be working with Mr Straw to prepare for the upcoming competition. We will be exploring the UNCRC to create a class charter. In addition, we will also be exploring ways to maintain and improve our mental wellbeing.

Social Studies

Our Social Studies this term will be Enterprise. As we look forward to our P7 residential trip to Ardentinny, we will be busy planning our fundraiser event. By experiencing the setting up and running of a business (non-profit), we will work collaboratively to make decisions and plan a successful event for the school - and hopefully raise lots of money too!

Maths & Numeracy

In Numeracy, we will be continuing our knowledge of place value and rounding and developing our skills through the use of larger numbers. We will be practising the 4 operations and working on identifying suitable mental strategies to use when solving word problems. In Maths, we will also be covering the different properties of 2D and 3D shapes using the correct vocabulary, whilst extending our knowledge to more complex shapes. We will also revise our knowledge of angles and be learning about the properties of a circle and classifying triangles. These activities will be differentiated to ensure that children are receiving the appro-

STEM

This term our Science topic will be micro-organisms. We will learn how to classify micro-organisms and how they can multiply rapidly. We will also learn how to prevent the spread of germs and undertake practical investigations.

Modern Languages

During French lessons we will be learning to describe physical appearances. We will continue to revise numbers within 100.

Expressive Arts

Our focus this term will be drawing skills. We will develop our knowledge of line, shape, tone and texture. In addition, we will be attending a music workshop led by Chris Kelly.
