

Literacy Health & Wellbeing

In Literacy, we will continue to learn and revise spelling patterns to help improve our spelling across all areas of the curriculum. Within writing we will be working to enhance our writing by using adjectives and descriptive phrases to engage the reader. We will be extending our knowledge of grammar by learning more about verbs and verb groups. We will also have fun exploring similes and metaphors. This term we will be reading a variety of texts and will work on creating literal, inferential and evaluative questions relevant to the text.

In PE, we will be developing our rugby skills and our general fitness through circuits. We will also be learning to create a sequence of jumps, balances and rotations in gymnastics. We will learn the importance of staying active on a daily basis and how it is important to achieve a good balance of sleep, rest and physical activity.

Social Studies Maths & Numeracy

Our Social Studies this term will be Spain. We will compare Scotland with Spain and investigate the main features of weather and climate, discussing the impact on living things. We will learn how the physical environment influences the ways in which people use the land and we will be able to locate key features on a map.

In Numeracy, we will continue to undertake our daily mental maths activities which cover all aspects of numeracy and maths. We will start the term off by learning how to multiply 5 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers. We will have fun by exploring well known number sequences including Pascal's Triangle and the Fibonacci Sequence. We will explore fractions, decimals and percentages in greater detail including problem solving and using these calculations in real life contexts. These activities will be differentiated to ensure that children are receiving the appropriate levels of

STEM

This term our Science topic will be Animals. We will learn how to classify living things into plants, animals and other groups through knowledge of their characteristics. We will also learn how some plants and animals have adapted to their environment and how this has contributed to their survival, or extinction.

Modern Languages

During French lessons we will be learning school nouns and asking questions about our classroom. We will continue to revise numbers within 100 and personal descriptions.

Expressive Arts

This term we will have the opportunity to develop our 3D art skills by creating clay lizards linking to our Spanish topic. We will also create a Largs collage scene using art straws.

RME	Digital Technologies
This term our RME topic will be exploring Christmas traditions around the world.	We will learn to download, edit, save and share Word documents this term. We will also work collaboratively with others online, in real time, to produce a shared presentation.
