Literacy

Reading– This term we will be focusing on retelling a familiar story, we are learning how to identify the main points of a story and we will be working together on our summarising skills. We will continue the routine of sending reading books out on a Monday (P2) and Wednesday (P3) and returning books by Friday. Thank you for the reading aloud practise you are undertaking at home. It really is making a difference.

Writing- We will continue to work on sentence structure and adding description and detail to up level our writing. This term the children will have the opportunity to write a variety of poems; rhyming poems, acrostic poems, haiku poems. We will use Halloween, Fireworks and Remembrance as stimulus.

Health & Wellbeing

We are exploring the Zones of Regulation, helping the children recognise their feelings and learn strategies to regulate their emotions. Through discussion, stories and activities, we will focus on identifying emotions, understanding triggers and finding positive ways to manage difficult situations.

This term we will be learning about how we keep ourselves healthy through diet, exercise, sleep and hy-

RME

As winter draws in we will be learning about Festivals of Light from different world religions. We will be focusing on Diwali from the Hindu religion, Hanukah from the Jewish religion & Christmas from the Christian religion.

We will also explore the Scandinavian concept of Hygge where darkness is embraced and families enjoy the cosiness and togetherness that winter brings.

Maths & Numeracy

Our focus this term will be addition and subtraction. We will be working on our mental maths ability, using our knowledge of bonds to ten to work out addition and subtraction of larger numbers. We will be learning how to lay out 2 digit (P2) and 3 digit (P3) addition and subtraction problems in order to help us find the answer to more challenging sums.

We will continue to use Sumdog and TopMarks websites to consolidate our learning both in class and for homework tasks.

STEM

Our science topic this term is Sound. We will be investigating how sounds are made, how they travel, and how we can change their volume and pitch. The children will have opportunities for hands-on experiments and outdoor investigations.

Modern Languages

This term we will focus on learning some of the French words for animals. We will also investigate some French traditions and vocabulary around the celebration of Christmas.

Expressive Arts

Art & Design - We will support our RME topic this term by having the opportunity to make some Hindu Rangoli patterns. We will also use clay to mould and fashion a Diva lamp.

Music - We will be learning some traditional Christmas songs in both English and French.

Social Subjects

Our class will be learning about Remembrance and the charity work Poppy Scotland undertakes. We will contribute to a whole school assembly.

Digital Technologies

We will continue to build on our word processing skills. This term we will focus on how to upload a picture and write a caption.

Useful Additional Information

This term we hope to do lots of work in the garden. We love being outside and learning about the world around us. In the coming weeks we will be preparing our raised bed for planting in the Spring.
