

Literacu

In writing, we will be focusing on character descriptions, learning to use adjectives to make our writing more detailed and making our sentences flow to make them easier to read. Later in the term, the children will create a fireworks poem, exploring descriptive language and imagery. In Reading, we will continue to develop fluency and understanding through guided reading sessions. Spelling and phonics will remain a key focus, helping us to build confidence in both reading and writing.

Health & Wellbeing

We are exploring the Zones of Regulation, helping children recognise their feelings and learn strategies to regulate their emotions. Through discussion, stories and activities, we will focus on identifying emotions, understanding triggers and finding positive ways to manage different situations.

Social Studies

This term in Social Studies, we will be learning about Remembrance, exploring why we wear poppies and how we remember the people who have helped to keep us safe. The children will learn about the significance of Remembrance Day, take part in reflective activities, and create poppy-themed artwork to show respect and understanding. We will also explore Fireworks and Bonfire Night, learning about the history and traditions linked to this celebration. The children will discuss fire safety and how communities come together to celebrate safely.

Maths & Numeracy

This term we will continue to build confidence in number work, focusing on addition and subtraction and developing strategies to solve problems accurately. We will also practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, exploring number patterns and early multiplication ideas. Children will be encouraged to set out their work neatly in jotters and to explain their thinking when solving problems.

STEM

Our science topic this term is Sound. We'll be investigating how sounds are made, how they travel, and how we can change their volume and pitch. The children will have opportunities for hands-on experiments and outdoor investigations.

Modern Languages

In French, the children will be practising greeting people, responding appropriately and introducing ourselves. We will continue to sing and enjoy some French songs.

Expressive Arts

Our art projects this term will be inspired by the season and our RME learning. The children will create a Street Scene using cutouts, explore colour mixing and collage, and make tissue collages and clay pots. We'll also design and decorate Diva lamps as part of our learning about Divali and experiment with firework-inspired art using mixed media. In Music we will be singing songs about Divali and the Festival of light.

This term we will explore Festivals of Light, learning about Divali, Hanukkah and Christmas. We'll also learn about the story of Rama and Sita, and how light is used as a symbol of hope and celebration across different religions and cultures.

Digital Technologies

We will continue to develop our mouse control and basic computer skills. The children will practise logging into Sumdog and begin to learn word processing, including typing simple sentences and using basic formatting tools.
