Literacy

In Literacy we will be extending our knowledge of grammar by learning about different types of speech and how to correctly punctuate speech. This term we will be reading a variety of non-fiction texts from a wide range of sources, including the internet and identifying which sources are most useful/reliable. Our writing will focus on functional writing and we will be creating instructions, posters and lists to tie in with our non-fiction reading and our WW2 topic. We will also improve our Listening and Talking skills by taking part in a class debate. As always, we will continue to learn and revise spelling patterns to help improve our spelling across all areas of the curriculum.

Health & Wellbeing

In PE, we will be developing our basketball and badminton skills. We will work together to explore and choose movements to create dance routines, developing our skills and techniques. We will learn and recognise that each of us has a unique blend of abilities and needs. We will make full use of the opportunities we are given to improve and manage our learning.

Social Studies

Our Social Studies this term will be WW2. We will learn to use primary and secondary sources of information to research this topic. We will be learning about the Clydebank Blitz, the Battle of Britain, weapons used in WW2 and D-Day. We will explore the world map to identify which countries took part in WW2 and we will learn about the Holocaust and its impact. To empathise with how difficult rationing was, we will try online shopping using current day rationing.

Maths & Numeracy

In Numeracy, we will continue to undertake our daily mental maths activities which cover all aspects of numeracy and maths. Our skills and knowledge of money will be developed to solve more complex problems. We will learn how to calculate the area of a right angled triangle and the volume of a cube/cuboid by using the correct formulas. We will also recognise and understand the concept of rotational symmetry. These activities will be differentiated to ensure that children are receiving the appropriate levels of support and challenge.

STEM

Our two Science topics this term will be Electricity and Light and Sound. We will learn how to design and build a variety of electrical circuits for different purposes using a range of components. We will explore reflections, the formation of shadows and the mixing of coloured light and we will be able to explain how sound vibrations are carried by waves through the air, water and other media.

Modern Languages

During French lessons we will be learning how to give directions around our school and town. We will continue to revise numbers within 100 and personal descriptions.

Expressive Arts

This term we will further develop our collage skills by creating a Blitz landscape using torn and cut tissue. We will also be painting monochrome portraits of each other. Inspired by a range of stimuli, we will express our ideas thoughts and feelings through creative dance.

RME

This term our RME topic will be investigating and reflecting upon Jewish traditions.

Digital Technologies

We will be learning the importance of citing sources that we use in our presentations and checking the reliability of sources before using information in projects.
