Literacy

Health & Wellbeing

This term we have started our literacy program with the Katie Morag stories. We are looking at the characters, setting and plot. We will continue to explore these areas of text through our individual reading books. We will also be developing our predicting skills and answering questions in full sentences.

Our writing focus this term is personal writing, writing about ourselves and our experiences. Our target will be to use basic punctuation including use of capital letters and full stops.

We will also be developing our talking and listening skills in class as we establish our class routines.

P2T have been working together to create a class charter. In our class we have decided to— Be kind, be ready, be respectful and be safe.

We are also using our zones of regulation and the strategies we have learned to help keep us healthy and happy in class.

Social Studies

Maths & Numeracy

Our topic this term is based on the stories of Katie Morag. We will be finding out about living on an island and comparing this to life on the mainland. We will use maps to investigate coastal towns like Largs and learn how to create simple maps of our own.

Our focus this term will be place value. We will be working on numbers to 100. We will be using the vocabulary— before, after, in between, more and less than. We will be learning how to add 10 and multiples of 10 to a given number.

We will be using Sumdog in class to consolidate our learning.

We will be learning the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

STEM

This term, we will investigate floating and sinking by designing sturdy boats or ferries to deliver the island mail bags safely across the sea.

Modern Languages

P2T will be learning how to greet each other in French during our morning check-in and through some French songs and games. We will also revise numbers and colours in French.

Expressive Arts

We will be drawing tartan patterns (like Katie's skirt) and painting atmospheric coastal landscapes focusing on textures of seaweed, sand, and ocean waves. Through drama activities P2 will be engaging in drama activities involving discussion and sharing of ideas and presenting ideas to other members of the class

We will be looking at the Christian bible story of Baby Moses and exploring family, care and protection.

This term we will learn about online safety through a variety of stories including Digi Duck. P2T will also be developing keyboard skills when using our laptops.
