STARTING BACK

Early Years opens at 8am. Term Time and Full Years children will attend Early Years following the pattern of attendance that was confirmed by North Ayrshire Council and Early Years staff.

Breakfast Club for Primary School pupils opens from 8.15am. There is no need to pre-register for the Breakfast Club, it is open to all Primary School pupils. Currently there is no cost for making use of the Breakfast Club thanks to our partnership working with the Greggs Foundation.


Primary School doors open at 9am. If your child is not attending the breakfast club then pupils should not enter the school grounds until 8.50am. Playground supervision is not provided at this time and pupils should not make use of any of the equipment that is present in the playground.

We are especially looking forward to welcoming our **Primary 1** pupils on Thursday. We enjoyed having our Primary 1 children and families in over the summer break in July and August. Our Breakfast Club is open to P1 from the very first day. We are keen to see all our Primary 1 children in for 9am. However, on their first day we are happy to give families a little flexibility with the latest start time being 9.30am.

Families and pupils can **access the school grounds** using the Front Gates (Ayr Road side) or the Back Gate (Merryvale Road cul-de-sac side). Primary School pupils should not make use of the access road to the rear of the school. The bike/scooter stand for primary school children has been temporarily relocated to the Infant Playground.

Work will soon commence on the **demolition of the high rise flats**. We ask that children making use of Ayr Road remain on the McKinley Crescent side of Ayr Road and cross at the zebra crossing point where the crossing control person is based. We will share further information as we receive it.

We ask that **parking is done responsibly**, avoiding the school carpark, community centre carpark, driveway entrances of our neighbours and the No Parking Lines at the school gates. There is ample parking throughout the length of Merryvale Road for families to park and stride.

ATTENDANCE

There was a marked improvement in attendance in our last term as the challenges of Covid on our community significantly eased. We hope that this improving trend continues throughout the school session. It is well known that there is clear link between attendance and attainment. We will welcome additional staffing this session to provide support where attendance is a challenge. It is important that parents notify the school office of all absences before 9am. Please make use of the direct telephone number – 01294 279031. You can also make use of the Xpressions App (see below) to leave a message for us to call you back. We require to account for the whereabouts of all our children each day. We wish to avoid undertaking any home visits by a member of the Senior Management Team or our new Area Inclusion Worker where no contact has been made. Where there is a pattern of poor attendance, including lateness, we will work with parents and pupils to see what supports we can provide. Parental support with our focus on attendance is greatly appreciated.

MEDICATION


We wish to ensure that medication for primary school children is in place for the commencement of the new session. Medication cannot be held by the school or administered until the completion of appropriate paperwork. All prescribed medications must be clearly labelled with the name of your child. If you wish to have your child's medication to be in place at the start of the new session then we ask that you complete information using the link below.

HOME TIME

Our Primary school finishing time is 3pm. Our school grounds are an extension of our playrooms / classrooms and we can make use of our grounds up until 2.45pm each day. We politely ask that you do not enter the school grounds until 2.45pm. Similar to the previous two years, exit arrangements will remain the same to allow a smooth exit. **P1 and P2 children and their older** siblings will exit into the side playgrounds. We ask that P1 parents and P2 parents keep to their side of the playground to allow a smooth hand over children by staff. Remaining **P3 to P7 children** will exit out the main entrance. We ask that P3 to P7 parents continue to wait for their children in the Senior Playground. Please avoid standing in front of the main entrance and within the two exit paths. Please make use of the ample space provided in the playground. Again, if travelling by car, please park responsibly.
