## P7 to S1 Transition Challenge Day #1 - Creative Arts

We are now looking forward to the first P7 to S1 Transition Challenge Day, which is being held next Tuesday on 27th September at Irvine Royal Academy.

The focus of the first challenge day is Creative Arts. Irvine Royal's artists and musicians are busy planning in preparation for pupils' arriving.

On Tuesday morning our pupils will be joining peers from Castlepark Primary School. Annick and Castlepark Primary Schools will undertake their transition event in the afternoon.

Pupils will travel by Irvine Royal's mini-bus to this event.

Pupils will have an early morning break before departing to the Academy and will then return to Loudoun-Montgomery in time for their afternoon lunch.

## P7 to S1 Transition Challenge Day #1 – Creative Arts

During Terms 1, 2 and 3 all P7 pupils benefit from generic transition events that will support their progression to secondary education. These inputs are provided by the secondary establishment within each primary school's cluster. Loudoun-Montgomery is part of the Irvine Royal Academy Cluster. Inputs covers a variety of relevant topic areas, including curriculum, pastoral and world of work. These inputs are delivered within Loudoun-Montgomery and Irvine Royal Academy. These generic transition events are provided to support all P7 pupils to prepare for S1 and beyond, regardless of their secondary school destination in August 2023.
