

School Meals

School meals are even healthier with the introduction in April 2021 of new nutritional regulations which detail the nutritional standards for all food and drink served in schools.

The new regulations provide:

- increase access to fruit and vegetables, ensuring children and young people can access their five-a-day at school;
- reduced the amount of sugar that can be accessed in school and
- brings provision of red processed meat in line with the Scottish Dietary Goals

Ordering Your Child's School Meal

This can be done at home using an iPayimpact Account or your child can do this each morning in class – you choose.

Before your child starts school in August we will provide you with information to support your registration for an iPayImpact account.

You will receive a communication from North Ayrshire Council's Facilities Management which will include an Account Reference number for your child. This letter will also detail how you can access the website and provides instructions on how to use the website to make payments, PRE ORDER MEALS and review the order history for your child. You can pre order your child's meal choice up to 3 weeks in advance!
