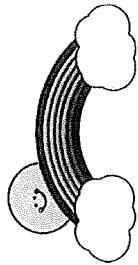


Feel free to complete as many activities as you wish - try to pick some from each colour.

Can you add the correct punctuation to these sentences? I like dogs What is your name	Practice writing your first and second name.
	
	


Numeracy Activities

Pick 2 numbers and add them together. $4 + 1 = 5$ $2 + 7 = 9$	Have a look around your house for things that are symmetrical.

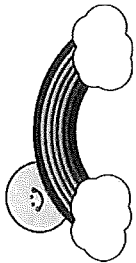
Health and Wellbeing Activities



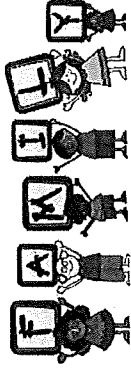

		Draw some 2D shapes and try to cut them out. 

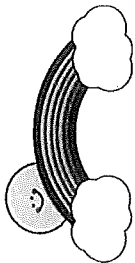
Health and Wellbeing Activities

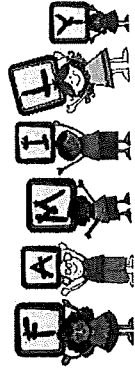

		Draw a picture of your favourite toy, can you say/write words to describe it? 

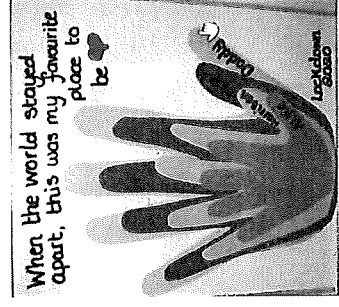
Numeracy Activities

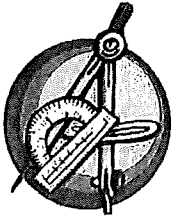

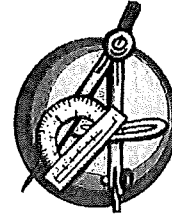
