## **NUMERACY & MATHS**

This term our topics include:

#### **Place Value**

We are consolidating our understanding of 5,6 and 7 digit numbers.

- Read and write numbers.
- Write numbers in words.
- Order, compare and round numbers.

#### Measure

We are learning about length, area and capacity.

- Practise reading from a range of scales with different intervals eg: a measuring jug.
- Convert between known standards of units.
- Estimate and measure the weight of food and household items.
- Estimate and measure the length of household and garden equipment.

#### **Multiplication**

Recite and recall times table facts! Remember. your times table skills help you with most other numeracy & maths topics!

## **LITERACY**

Sign out a book from the class library to improve your literacy skills at home.

#### Reading

We are learning to choose a suitable text to read for enjoyment.

- Choose a text to read at home. Read for at least 15 minutes minutes every day.
- Skim and scan the book for up-levelled vocabulary.
- Compare characters in a text.
- If you could interview the character, what would vou ask?
- Summarise each chapter and the story so far.
- Predict what you think could happen next, using your knowledge of the text so far.

#### **Spelling**

- Use your class spelling words to practise at home - ask a partner to give you a spelling test.
- Write your words in a story.
- Ask a partner to write the words incorrectly. Can you correct them?
