

## Our School Day




Children will finish school at 3pm. This finish time is the same for all children. Pick up points will be identified through our virtual tour.

Learning at Montgomerie
Park Primary in P1









Children in all stages of learning at Montgomerie Park Primary will access the great outdoors. This will be in varying forms. Our classrooms have direct access to our playground, the teachers may set up learning activities for children to access outside.

Our school grounds have been created to allow us to explore our local community in a safe and accessible way.

We are also close to Eglinton Park- we will use the park at varying times across the year to enhance our outdoor learning experiences.

Children are entitled to 2hrs of physical education every week. Children will be allocated specific slots, this will be shared with parents in the new term to allow the children to ensure they bring their indoor PE kit.

Children across early level of Curriculum for Excellence will access their learning through play. We will share our play journey with parents and allow you to visit our classrooms to become involved in our progressive play environment.

Preparing your child for primary 1 at Montgomerie Park Primary School





Talk to your child about attending primary school. Reassure them, share your starting school stories.



Encourage your child to get ready on their own, focus on zipping up jackets, doing up buttons, putting on their own shoes, this will help your child in primary 1.



Read with your child, encourage them to turn the pages of the book, talk about the pictures and the types of books they enjoy reading. This helps to expose children to early language skills.



Sharing nursery rhymes with your child stimulates the development of phonological awareness. It helps to reinforce new vocabulary and allows children to develop listening skills.
