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Headlice

We have been made aware of a few cases of headlice within the school. Unfortunately this is a common issue in schools. Please ensure you check your child's hair regularly and treat your child's hair until they are clear of headlice. Remember headlice can survive on clothing, towels, bed sheets etc. and all of those items should be washed thoroughly to avoid unwelcome visitors returning! If your child has headlice please alert the school office who will ask for parents in that class to check their child's hair.



Learning Café

Our learning cafés continue to be a big hit with the children and their grown-ups. We thank you for your continued support and engagement in your children's learning as this is crucial to their progress and success in school. **Please remember if you are unable to make it on any of the dates that any adult involved in your child's life is welcome to attend as long as the slip has been returned to school stating this.**

Trips

Staff are deciding on trips for the remainder of the session. Information regarding trips will come out to you from the school office. We try to make all trips either free or as little cost to you as we can.



It is important for your children to be in school and we would urge you to have your child in each day. Late comings also have a significant impact on your child's day and the progress they make. We are in the process of monitoring attendance for the second time this session. We will be making contact shortly with those families whose child's attendance is under 90%. Those who have attendance below this for the first time will receive an alert letter and those who have had attendance below this for the second time will be invited to meet with Mrs Heron and Lisa to discuss supports. We will work together to support your children into school each day, please let us know if you require any supports with this.

Communication

We pride ourselves in having extremely positive relationships with our learners; parents and carers and the extended Pennyburn community. Please do not hesitate to contact any of the leadership team if you have any questions or concerns and we will do our best to resolve the situation as quickly as possible. We may not always be able to take your call straight away but will always get back to you.
