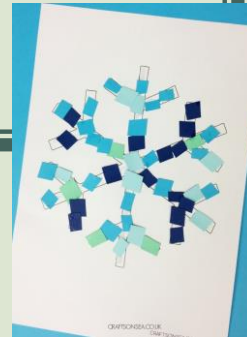

Design your own snowflake as individual as you!

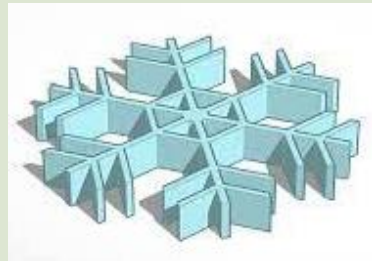
- Scale it up – A GIANT SNOWFLAKE

- Use outdoor chinks and materials
- Loose parts snowflake
- Collaborative snowflake

- Use digital technology like Tinkercad to design your own snowflake
- Use symmetry to design and draw a snowflake
- Use loose parts or outdoor materials

Some ideas :
