Session 2: Reading (Chapters 3 and 4)

Before Reading

Discuss what happened in Chapter 2 and how the children used the context to work out the meaning of *bien sūr*.

During Reading

Children consider the main question as they read to page 35.

Main question: **Which of the three people who handled the pudding might have been the culprit? (Y5 t2, Prediction)**

Additional prompts to help you sample children's reading:

Pages 23–26: What does Albert tell the children?

Page 28: What evidence do the police collect?

Pages 30–32: How did Marie-Claire feel about talking to the children?

Pages 33–35: How is Pierre's response different to the others?

After Reading

Discuss the main question with the children, giving them time to explain their thinking, and encourage them to refer to the text.

Children record their responses.

Follow-up: before Session 3, children read Chapter 5 and make notes about any changes to their predictions about the culprit.
