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Session 3: Reading (pages 24–31)

Before Reading

Discuss children's notes and how these sharks are camouflaged. Why do they need to be?

During Reading

Children consider the main question as they read to page 31.

Main question: **How do the photos make you feel? What view of sharks do the pictures and information give you?**

(Y5 t2, Personal Response and Evaluation of Text)

Additional prompts to help you sample children's reading:

Page 27: How does it feel when you look at the photo of lots of hammerhead sharks?

Pages 30–31: Which shark would you least like to meet? Why?

After Reading

Discuss the main question and talk about the impact of the photos. Do they make the information seem more real? Discuss whether all the children agree on their impression of sharks presented in this book and their reasoning.

Follow-up: children choose another two-page spread (not the one they read in Session 2), making notes on four interesting facts.
