

Session 2: Reading (pages 25–34)

Before Reading

- As a group, discuss children's previous predictions and whether they were right. How do they think the story will end?
- Ask the children to list the text types they have read so far and comment on which they prefer, and why.

During Reading

Children consider the main questions as they read to the end of the first story on page 34.

Main question: **What do you notice about the text types the author has used? (Y6 t1, Text Structure)**

Additional prompts

Page 25: Why does the show have this name?

Pages 27–29: What are the features of this text type?

Pages 30–32: Where would this text be found?

Pages 33–34: What type of magazine is this from?

After Reading

- Discuss the main question and why the author has included these text types. Children record their responses.
- Look at page 35. Predict how the story will continue.

Follow-up: before Session 3, children read to page 47 and write a radio transcript for what the wolf was actually doing.
