### Spanish Paella Recipe

**Method:** Heat some oil in a deep-frying pan then soften the leek for 5 mins without browning. Add the chorizo and fry until it releases its oils. Stir in rice until coated by the oils, then pour in the stock. Bring to the boil, then simmer for 15 mins, stirring occasionally. Tip in the peas and cook for 5 mins, then stir in the chicken to heat through for a final 1-2 mins cooking or until rice is cooked. Check for seasoning and serve immediately with lemon wedges.
