Maths & Numeracy

MATHS: All pupils will explore how to use simple directions and describe positions in movement, games and technology. They will also investigate ways in which data in presented and be able to ask and answer questions about the information it contains.

NUMERACY P1: Will develop a range of addition strategies.. P2: Will consolidate and extend their knowledge of addition and subtraction strategies to solve number problems within 20.

Literacy & English

PHONICS: Pupils will continue to develop their phonic skills either with Phase 2 or Phase 3 & 4.

HANDWRITING: We will continue to develop our letter and number formation as well as provide opportunities for the pupils to refine their line drawing skills.

WRITING: This term pupils will be explore recounts and procedural writing which will include writing their news as well as a range of instructions and recipes.

READING: Primary 1 pupils will now progress onto reading books which will allow them to apply their developing phonic skills. Primary 2 pupils will continue to develop their skills in reading both fiction and nonfiction texts. All pupils have Buddies from P6/7 and this has had a positive impact on their reading.

P.E.

In Term 2, will develop and extend their ball skills in game play with a focus on hockey and tennis . They will also learn a range of social dances. Our P.E. days will remain as **Tuesday** and **Wednesday** and for pupil safety, please ensure long hair is tied back and no jewelry is worn on those days.
